WINTER CEREALS PERFORMANCE TESTING IN MANITOBA 2018-2019

What crop types does MCVET test?

MCVET tests a variety of different crop types at a number of locations throughout Manitoba. Number of sites is dependent upon the crop type's adaptation to areas of Manitoba. All sites use a standardized protocol and are inspected by MCVET. Within crops, varieties are accepted for testing in either one of two categories:

CATEGORY 1 - Newly registered varieties or lines that have been supported for registration and are being grown/marketed in Manitoba. Registered varieties with limited Manitoba data and newly supported lines from a CFIA recognized recommending committee meeting in 2019 are eligible for testing. Please complete the attached "REQUEST TO TEST A NEW VARIETY" form and return by August 20th, 2018. We ask that a copy of the Official Coop data is supplied at the time of application to permit MCVET to develop a database containing non-yield agronomic data tables. There is currently no charge to variety sponsors for this service.

CATEGORY 2 - Sponsored Varieties/Advanced Coop Entries will be tested at the request of a company/institution, for a minimum contribution of \$250/entry/site. Sponsored varieties are Canadian registered varieties submitted by a company requesting additional testing by MCVET. Advanced coop entry implies that the company/institution intends to put the variety forward for registration at a CFIA recognized recommending committee meeting in 2018. Please complete the attached "REQUEST TO TEST A COOP ENTRY VARIETY" form and return by August 20th, 2018. If a company submits an unregistered entry on behalf of the breeder, MCVET will require a letter indicating that they are aware the entry is being tested from the breeder before the seed will be packaged.

****NOTE**** Seed is to be tagged with the variety name, % germination, and thousand kernel weight. If information is not provided with the seed: 100% germination will be assumed and a penalty fee of up to \$200 will be assessed if thousand kernel weight is not provided.

Seed should arrive before August 27th 2018. Seed received after August, 27th 2018 will be subject to a penalty fee of \$200 per variety. Seed received after August 31st, 2018 will not be included in the trials. If you cannot meet the deadline, please contact Chami Amarasinghe prior to the deadline (204) 823-2584.

ONLY 5KG OF SEED FOR NEW VARIETIES ARE REQUIRED DUE TO LIMITED TESTING LOCATIONS

Sub-samples of harvested plots for cereal crops will be taken for seed quality analysis purposes. Analysis will be conducted by a vendor selected by MCVET and the balance of seed retained in storage for three years for follow-up analysis if necessary. After the three year period samples will be destroyed. If the applicant/licensee of submitted varieties would like a portion of the sub-sample of submitted varieties returned to them this may be arranged at additional cost to the applicant/licensee. Additional charges will depend on the size of samples requested, number of locations/samples, and any additional sampling/handling/shipping fees.
